KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

NILDEN VARDAR is working in the Federal Ministry for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth, and deals there with questions of the promotion of democracy and radicalization prevention within the framework of the federal program "Living democracy! Active against right - wing extremism, violence and violence Enmity ". She graduated in Islamic Studies and Sociology at the Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms-University of Bonn. She has also worked as a scientific assistant in the Research Group of the Migration and Refugees (BAMF) in Nürnberg.

REINHARD FISCHER is M.A. in Islamic Studies from FU Berlin, worked as Neighbourhood Manager in a disadvantaged neighbourhood in Berlin and as Communication manager for an URBACT Network of European cities on Social Cohesion in disadvantaged neighbourhoods before joining the Berlin Center for Civic Education in 2014.

WERNER PRINZJAKOWITSCH is educated Social Worker (BA) and holds a Masters in Social and Health Care Management. He is active in Open Youth Work since 1984, working in different youth centres and directing youth centres from 1988. Since 2008 he is Educational Director of Association of Viennese Youth Centres, a non-profit with 300 employees and 36 units. Furthermore he is member of the Steering Committee of the Austrian Extremism Information Centre and Co-Chair of European Union RAN (Radicalisation Awareness Network) working group on "Youth, Families and Communities" (YFC).

NAVEED BAIG is a Danish born academician and imam. He works as a coordinator for Ethnic Ressourceteam at Rigshospitalet where he also serves as the Muslim chaplain/imam. Baig has a MA in spiritual care from the Faculty of Theology, University of Copenhagen and teaches as an external lecturer at various institutions including nursing schools in Copenhagen. His main field of work and interest is in intercultural communication, ethics, religion in the public sphere, and interfaith dialogue. Naveed Baig is also the vice-chair of the Islamic-Christian Study Center in Denmark.
